**Describe the work/ministry that was accomplished by the ministry team.**

Eagleville Baptist Church and Holts Corner Baptist Church went together again this year to do construction and to help Al and Margie Patterson at the center. Together we were able to do several jobs. Eagleville Baptist Church help build 3 wheel chair ramp for 3 families. We repainted a wheel chair ramp for a couple. We also put in 3 windows and a hot water heater and repaired a bathroom floor for a family. We repaired flashing on two roofs at two homes. We replaced part of a ceiling on a porch for a widow lady whose husband died last year. While there, we also replaced her front steps going into her house. Also cleaned out her gutters and put up her down spouts. We also put in another water heater at another home in the area.

The ladies on two days helped organized the Crisis Center, giving Margie a helping hand. They reorganized the stock room and also stocked the holding building where the supplies are kept. They then went to paint a Wheel chair ramp for a family. After painting there, they came and painted the porch ceiling at the house where we put up the new ceiling.

**What advice would you give to other churches who may be considering a similar mission project?** Have a back-up plan and be flexible. Three weeks prior to going to Copper Basin, we met with Al and Margie to see what work was needed to be done up there. We picked out two families that we felt needed our help the most. Getting home we got materials and supplies to take with us. BUT when we got up there to start working, both families were gone because of situation out of their control. So that after noon, we helped at the center while we looked through the application for help, to find where we would start the next day.
