Describe the work/ministry that was accomplished by the ministry team. The ladies of the team worked with Margie Patterson at the center and gave out food and clothes. Then on Thursday they came with men to help paint and repair wheel chair ramp. The men on Saturday went to a house to work on a kitchen and had to take off the whole back half of the house and put in a new wall and roof on the back half of the house. We rewired the back half to code and put in back wall and window. Our second project was the wheel chair ramp. We had to repair half of the ramp for this elderly couple. We did other little projects for them like plant flowers on the hill side of the front yard.

What advice would you give to other churches who may be considering a similar mission project? Be flexible and expect the job to be worse than you can imagine. What was told to Al Patterson wasn't what we found when we got there. At the house we were to fix the kitchen, but when we started tearing out the ceiling we saw a rotten roof. The bathroom and one bed room was also in very bad shape. So we tore off all of the bad and got in back in very good shape.
