Describe the work/ministry that was accomplished by the ministry team.

- A. A team of pastors worked with and trained local Haitian Pastors in the work of gospel ministry. Our teaching theme this trip was "Preaching Christ from the Old Testament."
- B. One team member worked on organizing clothing supplies delivered from the States and making sure each orphan and resident worker received new items.
- C. All workers at various times worked on construction projects. One such project was the future building and grounds which will house future missionaries and babies living at the orphanage. This building should be completed in 2015.
- D. One team worker served on the medical team which saw patients each day of the mission. This worked to treat sick Haitian patients and deliver Medical Mamba supplies to Mothers and Babies.
- E. Additionally, team members worked with the orphans in tutoring them through various subjects and participated in physical education each day.

What advice would you give to other churches who may be considering a similar mission project?

- A. Working in the same area with the same people each year is such a blessing. Our church is committed to going back here each year. Our partnership with Canaan Orphanage is a blessing both to them and especially us.
- B. Organizing mission opportunities where diverse ministries are undertaken gets wider participation from our people here in the States. Some do evangelism. Some do Pastor Training. Others work in orphan education. Yet, others are able to work construction. And some are able serve on the medical team. There is something for everyone to do.
