I would like to take this time to express our great gratitude to the Concord Association with its financial assistant with our mission trip to Toronto, Canada on July 21-28, 2012. Twenty-six of our church members (12 years-old to 66 years-old — many whole families) had the privilege of working with Blythwood Road Baptist Church in providing ...

- (1) A block party in a predominately Muslim and Jewish community.
- (2) A daycamp from 9am until 4pm each day, Monday—Friday in which we averaged 55 in attendance of which there were six professions of faith in Jesus Christ as Savior.
- (3) A work crew to cleaned up an area, installed a wall, door, window and tiled the floor for a new exercise area at the Horizon Youth Center.

Not that the mission trip wasn't exciting enough, but as God often does, I think our group and church were blessed the most. Five of the six children that were led to Christ were by one of our college students that had never before had the privilege of guiding someone toward Christ. Another of our high school students has expressed that she is feeling called to work with inner-city young girls.

We have been invited back for next year, which will be year three of our five year commitment to this mission project.

The financial assistance made it possible for many of our families to go. Again, thank you for your partnering with us in doing God's work.

Also, Blythwood Road Baptist Church would like to expand the ministry to another week. They are seeking another church in the area that would be willing to sponsor a week. Unfortunately, we cannot commit to another week, so I would like to offer this second week as a mission opportunity to the other churches in our Association.
