Again we are so gratefully for the financial assistance our church received from the Missions Ministry Assistance Fund for our School Day Mission Trip to Fed's Creek, Kentucky.

On July 19th, 2012, our pastor Shelby Smith, 9 adults and 1 child left Murfreesboro, with a trailer full of school supplies, clothing, shoes, party foods, bicycles, hygiene items, and even a small swimming pool. We left at 6:00 AM on a Friday morning, arriving at Fed's Creek Community Center around 3:00 PM, unloaded and set up the room for the following day.

On Saturday morning, we were ready to begin School Day in Fed's Creek. We had people waiting as we arrived. The first thing we did was have prayer for the efforts of every one involved and for each family that came by. Before they could get any clothing, school supplies, etc, Bro. Shelby shared with them the Plan of Salvation, had prayer and then the fun began. We stayed until 12:00 and then begin packing up the extra clothing and hygiene items which we gave to a ministry called God's Closet which is a ministry for those who cannot afford clothing. The bulk of the school supplies went to the Resource Lady at Fed's Creek K-8th elementary school, who would give the children the supplies they would need. The cookies that was left from the party was taken to the local senior nursing home

We had a church in Florida that donated \$280.00, another church in the association also gave money to help purchase school supplies, and we couldn't have going if not for the generosity of our Walter Hill folks who helped with yard sales, bake sales, egg roll sales. As near as we can figure our "School Day at Fed's Creek" ran in the area of \$4,495.00.
