Re: Fed's Creek Kentucky School Day Mission Trip – July 2016

Here is a review of our last mission trip to Fed's Creek, Kentucky in July of this year. We made two trips, on Friday the 17th carrying approximately 1800 lb of food for 250+ people, going back on Monday for School day ministering to about 100 children with school supplies and clothing. We also gave out devotional books and Bibles. There was a total of 5 to go on this trip. Below is a list of the approximate amount we spent for this trip.

Travel expenses: \$454.70 (lodging, food and fuel expense)
Devotional Books: \$90.00
School Supplies: \$1,750.00
Shoes & Clothing: \$1,885.00 (15 pair of new shoes priced at \$99.00 each)

Total spent on this trip: \$4,179.70

Fed's Creek which is in Pike County, the poorest county in Kentucky and the 16th in America.
