- A total of 10 individuals representing Northside Baptist church participated in this trip.
- We served at the International Christian School of Lima in Lima, Peru
- Our ministry schedule was:
 

8:30 to 9:30 am	Middle School/High School Chapel
9:30 to 10:15 am	Middle School/High School Activity Time
10:15 to 11:30 am	Middle School/High School Small Group Bible Study
11:30 am to 12:30 pm	Lunch for the Mission Team
12:30 pm to 1:00 pm	Lower & Upper Elementary Chapel
1:00 pm to 3:15 pm	K-5 <sup>th</sup> Grade Instructional and Activity Time
- For the 6<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> grade small group Bible Study time, we used Kyle Idelman's "Not A Fan" curriculum.
- During the K-5<sup>th</sup> grade instructional time, the kids rotated between 5 stations (Bible story, memory verse, activity time, game mat time, craft).
- The ladies on the team also ministered to some of the teachers with a Wednesday night Bible study (a majority of the teachers are young women for the United States that have left behind family to teach at this school).
- Around 10-12 students spoke with an adult about becoming a Jesus follower or a more committed Jesus follower.
