> Stones River Baptist Church mission team would like to thank you for being a large part of our summer mission effort to reach children for our Lord Jesus Christ. A few months back we were asked to be a part of a sport camp in east Tennessee. We partnership with the First Baptist Church, LaFollette, Tennessee to lead a baseball sport camp to reach children that live in a strong drug and alcohol environment. We had two groups each day; mornings were grades 3rd-5th and evening grades 6th-8th with a total of 52 boys and girls. Each group were coached by three of our team for two hours, every 20 minutes the children took a 5 minute water break at which time 2 of our team shared about Jonah and Daniel with the children. On Thursday the plan of salvation was shared with the children following the end of their practice with 5 praying inviting Jesus Christ into their heart for the very first time. Several children were under conviction, but did not make it public. On Friday night the children were divided into two teams and play a game with each be allow to catch and hit a ball. The plan of salvation was shared with the parents and grandparents (who were raising most of these children). Three of our girls painted the parking lot of the church, as well as, another church in the area.
