I will use this as our report for our recent mission trip to Belgium. We had a team of five including myself travel from Wednesday September 14th thru Sunday September 25th. We worked with John & Elizabeth Kea who are IMB missionaries in Namur Belgium. They were also members of 3BC before going on the mission field.

We participated in many activities, we visited with the Goen's in Brussels who are missionaries from Lifepoint church in Smyrna, We distributed Bible's in Namur, attended church with the Kea's, and generally observed the culture while there. The one observation that was very evident is the lostness that exists there. There is a very negative atmosphere about spiritual things and in general for anything that resembles church and Christ.

The one thing we took from this trip is the effort we must all have here to reach our community for Christ. My greatest fear I have is that the USA will look like Europe in the years to come. It is one of the darkest, coldest places I have ever been.

I am truly thankful that Concord association was able to help make this trip possible for those of us that went. It is extremely expensive with the trip costing about \$1500 per person plus meals.
