

Westwood Baptist Church would like to thank the Concord Baptist Association and particularly those responsible for dispersing Mission Funding for the recent help we received with our trip to Haiti. The financial help you provided was a great help for our members being able to afford to travel overseas.

The following is a basic report of activities and ministries we participated in while in Haiti:

1. Pastoral Training: Two from our mission team participated with two other pastors and trained 20 pastors from Haiti. We walked through an intensive study through the book of Ephesians.

2. Several team members work with the medical team. The medical team served most days in the clinic that is run as a ministry of the orphanage. One day, the medical team went off site to minister to physical needs in a nearby town.

Much of the team's time was spent with malnourished children and enrolling young kids and their families into a mamba nutrition program.

3. One of our members served the mission team through photography and video as a way to help promote the orphanage back in the states. We also are considering taking professional pictures and printing them there in Haiti next time because families typically have no family pictures in their homes.

4. Time was spent taking measurements of the orphans and dispersing the clothes and shoes we collected and took with us to Haiti.

5. A construction crew worked primarily laying tile in one of the new structures which is being built and a few worked on welding bars for security on other doors and windows.

6. Lastly, a few of our members helped in the education of the orphans. They only have a few teachers, so when missionary teams come, we can provide them with more one-on-one tutoring.
